ROAD CLOSURE: O'RIORDAN STREET

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

John Holland is carrying out work on behalf of ARTC in and near the rail corridor at locations in Mascot and Botany.

This work is required for the Botany Rail Duplication project. John Holland is contracted to design and construct the project, which will duplicate the remaining 2.9km section of single line track to Port Botany. This will allow freight to be moved more efficiently and effectively.

CLOSURE OF O'RIORDAN STREET (25 – 28 MARCH)

O'Riordan St, Mascot will be closed between Qantas/Joyce Drive and Robey Street from 11pm Friday 25 March to 5am Monday 28 March 2022. Please refer to map overleaf for work location.

Construction for this project can only take place during planned trackwork on the Botany freight line. It is important to make this work as safe as possible for workers and road users. Closing roads and removing traffic allows work to be carried out safely and efficiently.

Further road and lane closures may also be required to support the Botany Rail Duplication project and information will be provided in advance of future works.

The work will include:

- Removing an unused section of the O'Riordan Street bridge
- Piling work at O'Riordan Street bridge and Robey Street bridge
- Removing an advertising sign truss frame at O'Riordan Street bridge.

What to expect:

A 650-tonne crane will be set up on O'Riordan Street together with a mobile crane, vacuum truck, saw cutter, jack hammer, street sweeper and lighting tower.

There will be some noise associated with this work, but we will minimise this as much as possible:

- Where possible, noise blankets will used to minimise disturbance
- Vehicles and equipment will be switched off when not in use
- Vehicles and equipment are fitted with non-tonal reversing alarms
- Loading and unloading of materials will occur as far as possible from homes and hotels.


Changes to traffic and pedestrian access:

- Southbound vehicles will be diverted eastbound into Gardeners Road and can continue southbound by turning right into Botany Road.
- During the closure, Special Event Clearways will be in place on the eastern side of Botany Road (southbound) between Gardeners Road and Wentworth Avenue. These clearways will make an additional lane available for southbound motorists and will improve traffic flow on this section of Botany Road. Special event clearways are strict no-parking zones and also apply to local

- residents and Mobility Scheme Parking Permit holders. Vehicles left in clearways will be towed and fines will apply.
- Southbound motorists on Botany Road will not be able to turn right into Robey Street. Instead, these motorists should use King Street and O'Riordan Street to access Robey Street.
- Timetabled bus routes 350, 420 and N20 will be impacted over the weekend. A shuttle bus service (420S) will be operating at 10-minute intervals throughout the day and 20-minute intervals at night. These buses will run between Mascot and Sydney Airport Domestic.
- Pedestrians should use Robey Street and Qantas Drive to avoid the closure on O'Riordan Street.
 Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians. Access to residential properties will be maintained at all times.
- Electronic message boards will be in place on local streets to divert traffic.
- Parking near the work site may be temporarily removed during work.
