WHAT ARE WE DOING?

John Holland will be carrying out works on behalf of ARTC near you, in and near the rail corridor at locations in Mascot and Botany. John Holland is contracted to design and construct the project, which will duplicate the remaining 2.9km section of single line track to Port Botany. This will allow freight to be moved more efficiently and effectively.

UPCOMING WORK

WHEN: Monday to Friday (7am to 6pm) and Saturday (8am to 6pm), 1-31 July

WHAT: The following activities will take place during standard approved construction hours:

- Site inspections, signal investigations and surveying along the project alignment in the rail corridor
- Utility, potholing and geotechnical investigation work in the rail corridor
- Vegetation clearance along the project alignment
- Retaining wall construction along the project alignment
- Earthworks, hardstand and general concrete and drainage work along the project alignment
- Site access establishment work along the project alignment
- Piling and construction of foundations at O'Riordan Street, Robey Street and Mill Stream bridges
- Utility protection work along the project alignment
- Cable installation along the project alignment
- Utility excavation and relocation work along the project alignment.

The work in your area will not be continuous. The majority of work will take place during standard approved construction hours, which are: Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm, and 8am to 6pm on Saturdays.

TRAFFIC CHANGES: the shoulder lane on Southern Cross Drive will be closed in both directions near Southern Cross Drive Bridge, until February 2023 (see map on next page).

NOISE AND VIBRATION: Piling will involve intermittent high noise during installation of the pile casings, and this will be audible at nearby properties. During some earthworks, compaction of materials may involve a method which causes vibration. People can be sensitive to vibration and can detect vibration levels that are well below the threshold for any risk of damage to buildings. Our project team will monitor vibration levels to determine minimum working distances from nearby residents and businesses.

High impact works, including pile casing installation and vibratory rolling, will be carried out from **8am to 6pm Monday to Friday and 8am to 1pm Saturdays** in continuous blocks not exceeding three hours, with a minimum of one hour respite provided. **High noise impact works** will also take place during a weekend track closure on **1-4 July** (see information on next page).

Due to the nature of construction activities and for the safety of workers, some work will occur outside standard construction hours. Every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community wherever possible.

Some equipment will also be delivered outside standard construction hours in line with Transport for NSW requirements for transporting oversized vehicles.

OUT OF HOURS WORK

WHEN: Weekend track closure work from 10.30pm, Friday 1 July to 6am, Monday 4 JulyWHAT: The following activities will take place:

- Piling work at O'Riordan and Robey Street bridges
- Cable service routes construction and relocation work along the project alignment
- Vegetation clearing adjacent to the Southern Cross Drive bridge.

TRAFFIC CHANGES: Intermittent lane closures will take place **on Qantas Drive approaching Robey and O'Riordan Streets, between 11pm and 4am during the weekend**, to allow for deliveries of materials and equipment. Traffic controllers will be on site to assist motorists and pedestrians.

High-noise impact work (including installation of the pile casings) will be carried out from <u>8am to 10pm</u> <u>Saturday 2 July</u> and from <u>8am to 6pm Sunday 3 July</u>. These works will be carried in continuous blocks of no more than three hours, with at least one hour of respite between each block of continuous high noise impact work.

WHEN: Nightworks 6pm to 6am (weeknights) and 1pm to 6pm (Saturdays), 1-31 JulyWHAT: The following activities will take place:

- Cable installation and survey investigation work along the project alignment
- Barrier installation work at Southern Cross Drive
- Piling work at O'Riordan Street, Robey Street and Mill Stream bridges
- Machinery and equipment deliveries inside Banksia Street compound and at O'Riordan Street and Robey Street bridges
- Concrete pour works along the project alignment
- Retaining wall construction along the project alignment
- Out of hours material deliveries and mobilisation of machinery and equipment.

The out of hours work will not be continuous. Residents will be notified at least five days before out of hours work in their area. Every effort will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum and works will be monitored to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively. Equipment will be turned off when not in use and where required, noise blankets will be set up around work sites.

SITE ESTABLISHMENT: Residents will be advised of any out of hours work or access at the Banksia Street compound. Verbal communication will be kept to a minimum on site and machinery will be turned off when not in use. Locations at Botany Road and General Holmes Drive will be used as the main site compounds.

EQUIPMENT: Excavators, piling rigs, mobile cranes, grader, vacuum trucks, concrete pump truck, elevated work platform, front end loader, roller-compactors, power hand tools, surveying equipment, geotechnical investigation rigs, construction vehicles, lighting towers, work trucks and traffic control signs and barriers.


TRAFFIC: Vehicles will access the rail corridor via existing rail corridor access gates at Botany Road and along various project alignment access gates in the rail corridor. While most vehicles will be located inside the rail corridor during the works, some vehicles may be parked in the street close to these locations.

Intermittent lane closures on Botany Road, Southern Cross Drive, Robey Street, O'Riordan Street, Banksia Road, Mill Pond Road and McBurney Avenue may be required to facilitate site deliveries.

COVID: All teams will follow the relevant safety protocols and Government guidelines relating to COVID.
