WEEKEND HIGH NOISE WORKS: 13-15 AUGUST

Weekend track reconditioning work will be carried out in your area during a scheduled rail shutdown to ensure the safety of workers. Construction activities are carefully planned to minimise impacts on the community. Please see the map overleaf for the location of works.

WHEN: Nightwork from **2am Saturday 13 August to 5am Monday 15 August 2022**

WHAT: The following activities will take place:

- Track reconditioning work, which will involve track cutting, rail dragging, track resurfacing, welding and tamping
- Excavation work.

Equipment for this work will include: excavators, drum rollers, tampers, rail saws, rail turnout machine, front end loader, hand tools, construction vehicles.

Various measures are taken to keep noise to a minimum, such as scheduling noisier works earlier in the night where possible and installing noise blankets. **The work in your area will not be continuous and every effort will be made to keep noisy work to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community where possible.**

The **Noise and Vibration fact sheet** located at botanyduplication.com.au identifies construction activities and their associated noise levels in decibels (dBA). The noise levels associated with the track reconditioning works have been predicted between **67dBA and 88dBA** and as a result, indicates that there will be noise impacts in your area. Respite vouchers will be offered to residents who are **directly impacted** by the work.

Below are details of high noise activities and the current scheduled timings for these activities. Lower impact construction works will be occurring at other times during the weekend possessions.

HIGH IMPACT TRACK WORK:

- Rail saw cutting: approximately 15 minutes activity (short duration activity), scheduled for early Saturday morning at the start of work
- Loading, unloading and installing ballast: 6-hour activity, scheduled for Saturday evening/Saturday night and Sunday morning
- Rail dragging: 2 to 3-hour activity, scheduled for Saturday morning and Saturday evening/Saturday night and Sunday morning
- Track resurfacing: 4 to 6-hour activity, scheduled for Sunday between 6am and 6pm (please note the track resurfacing machine will not be working constantly through this period).

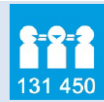
MANAGEMENT MEASURES:

- High noise activities to be kept to a minimum
- Respite periods to be provided for high noise activities
- Non-tonal reversing and other equipment alarms (white noise instead of a 'beep-beep')
- Equipment to be turned off when not in use
- Noise blankets to be used around activities where practicable
- Noise monitoring to be carried out during the works and additional mitigation measures applied as identified.
