

NIGHT WORK LANE CLOSURES

FULL NIGHT SOUTHBOUND LANE CLOSURE ON SOUTHERN **CROSS DRIVE, MASCOT (5 OCTOBER TO 7 OCTOBER 2022)**

John Holland will be carrying out works on behalf of ARTC on Southern Cross Drive, Mascot. These works are required for the Botany Rail Duplication. Part of these works will include the installation of a new rail bridge adjacent to the existing rail bridge on Southern Cross Drive, Mascot. It is important to make this work as safe as possible for workers and road users. Temporarily closing lanes at night and removing traffic allows for the work to be done safely and often in a shorter amount of time.

Works for the new rail bridge on Southern Cross Drive will require a full night time Southbound closure on Southern Cross Drive between Wentworth Avenue and General Holmes Drive, from 9.00pm to 5.00am on Wednesday 5 October, Thursday 6 October and Friday 7 October. The closure is required to install two bridge piles required for the new rail bridge at this location. The third lane Northbound (closest to the central reservation) will also be closed to help facilitate these works.

The work will include:

- Preparation for the installation of the two new bridge piles
- Installation of road barriers
- Installation of road signage.

What to expect:


- There will be some noise associated with this work, but we will minimise this as much as possible
- Where possible, noise blankets will used to minimise disturbance
- Vehicles will be switched off when not in use
- Loading and unloading of materials to occur as far as possible from sensitive receivers
- Traffic control will be in place to manage traffic and pedestrian access
- Electronic messaging boards will be set up around local streets to divert traffic
- Equipment to install the two piles will include a crane, excavator, lighting tower and delivery trucks.

Changes to traffic

Traffic control will be in place to assist motorist and pedestrians during the full night closure of the southbound lanes on Southern Cross Drive. A direct detour will be implemented to provide an alternate route to road users. The detour route for Southbound traffic on Southern Cross Drive will be via Wentworth Avenue and General Holmes Drive, as shown on the map on the next page.
