WHAT ARE WE DOING?

John Holland will be carrying out work on behalf of ARTC near you, in and near the rail corridor at locations in Mascot and Botany. John Holland is contracted to design and construct the project, which will duplicate the remaining 2.9km section of single line track to Port Botany. This will allow freight to be moved more efficiently and effectively.

The majority of work will take place during standard approved construction hours, which are: Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm, and 8am to 6pm on Saturdays. Some of this work may be noisy.

Due to the nature of construction activities and for the safety of workers, some work will occur outside standard construction hours. Some equipment will also be delivered outside standard construction hours in line with Transport for NSW requirements for transporting oversized vehicles.

WHEN: Monday to Friday (7am to 6pm) and Saturday (8am to 6pm), 1-31 May

WHAT: The following activities will take place during standard approved construction hours.

Mascot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Drainage installation and channel construction near King Street • Cable and signalling installation work near Coleman Street and Robey Street bridge • Removal of temporary block walls at Coleman Street • Retaining and deflection wall work between Robey and O’Riordan Streets • Concrete patching at Robey Street bridge • Demolition of eastern existing abutment and installation of drainage pipes and pits at Robey Street bridge • Welding, formwork, steelwork and concrete work on O’Riordan Street bridge • Jackhammering (pile trimming) near O’Riordan Street bridge • Concrete work and track formation near O’Riordan Street bridge • Piling work and sewer protection structure construction near Baxter Road • Earthwork, drainage and utility installation work between Wentworth Avenue and O’Riordan Street • Formwork, welding, spoil removal and oxy cutting work at General Holmes Drive and Baxter Road compounds • Movement of materials near General Holmes Drive compound • Installation of concrete barriers near Botany Road compound • Construction of retaining wall and drainage work at Botany Road compound

WHEN: Weekend track closure work from 2.00am, Saturday 5 May to 2.00am, Monday 8 May

WHAT: The following activities will take place:

Mascot	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Track tamping (compacting the rock layer under the tracks) near Cooks River Loop (next to Qantas Drive), King Street and Coleman Street • Cable installation, track construction and signalling foundation work near Coleman Street, Robey Street bridge and Wentworth Avenue bridge • Track reconstruction and tamping work between General Holmes Drive compound and Baxter Road • Installation of Sydney Water services near General Holmes Drive compound • Retaining wall earthworks and sewer protection structure piling near Baxter Road • Formation construction, which includes earthwork and track construction, near O’Riordan Street bridge • Concrete work on O’Riordan Street bridge
Botany/Pagewood/Banksmeadow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Concrete works near Mill Stream • Earthworks in the rail corridor between Mill Stream and Banksia Street • Installation of drainage pipes and headwall near Mill Stream • Installation of drainage pipes and headwall near Myrtle Street and Bay Street • Service protection slab work at Ocean Street

OUT OF HOURS WORK

WHEN: 1-31 May: Nightwork 6pm to 6am, 1pm to 6pm (Saturdays), Sundays 8am-6pm (non-disruptive work)

SITE COMPOUNDS

Site compounds are used for the storage of equipment and materials. They also contain site facilities including meeting rooms and toilets. Compounds are located at: General Holmes Drive, Baxter Road and Botany Road in Mascot, and Banksia Street in Botany. Verbal communication will be kept to a minimum on site and machinery will be turned off when not in use.

EQUIPMENT USED

Excavators, jackhammer, rail saw, piling rigs, mobile cranes, grader, vacuum trucks, concrete pump trucks, elevated work platform, front end loader, roller-compactors, power hand tools, surveying equipment, semi-trailers, geotechnical investigation rigs, compaction equipment, construction vehicles, lighting towers, trucks and traffic control signs and barriers.

NOISE AND VIBRATION

During some earthwork, vibration piling, and compaction of materials may involve a method which causes vibration. People can be sensitive to vibration and can detect vibration levels that are well below the threshold for any risk of damage to buildings. Our project team will monitor vibration levels to determine minimum working distances from nearby residents and businesses.

Every effort will be made to keep noisy work to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community where possible. The Noise and Vibration fact sheet located at botanyduplication.com.au identifies construction activities and their associated noise levels in decibels (dBA).

HOW WE’RE MANAGING IMPACTS

Some of this work will be noisy. Impacted residents will be notified at least five days before out-of-hours work in their area. Every effort will be made to keep noise levels to a minimum and work will be monitored to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively.

Management measures include respite periods for high noise activities, non-tonal reversing and other equipment alarms (white noise instead of a ‘beep-beep’), turning off equipment and machinery when not in use, keeping verbal communication to a minimum, and installing noise blankets where possible.

TRAFFIC

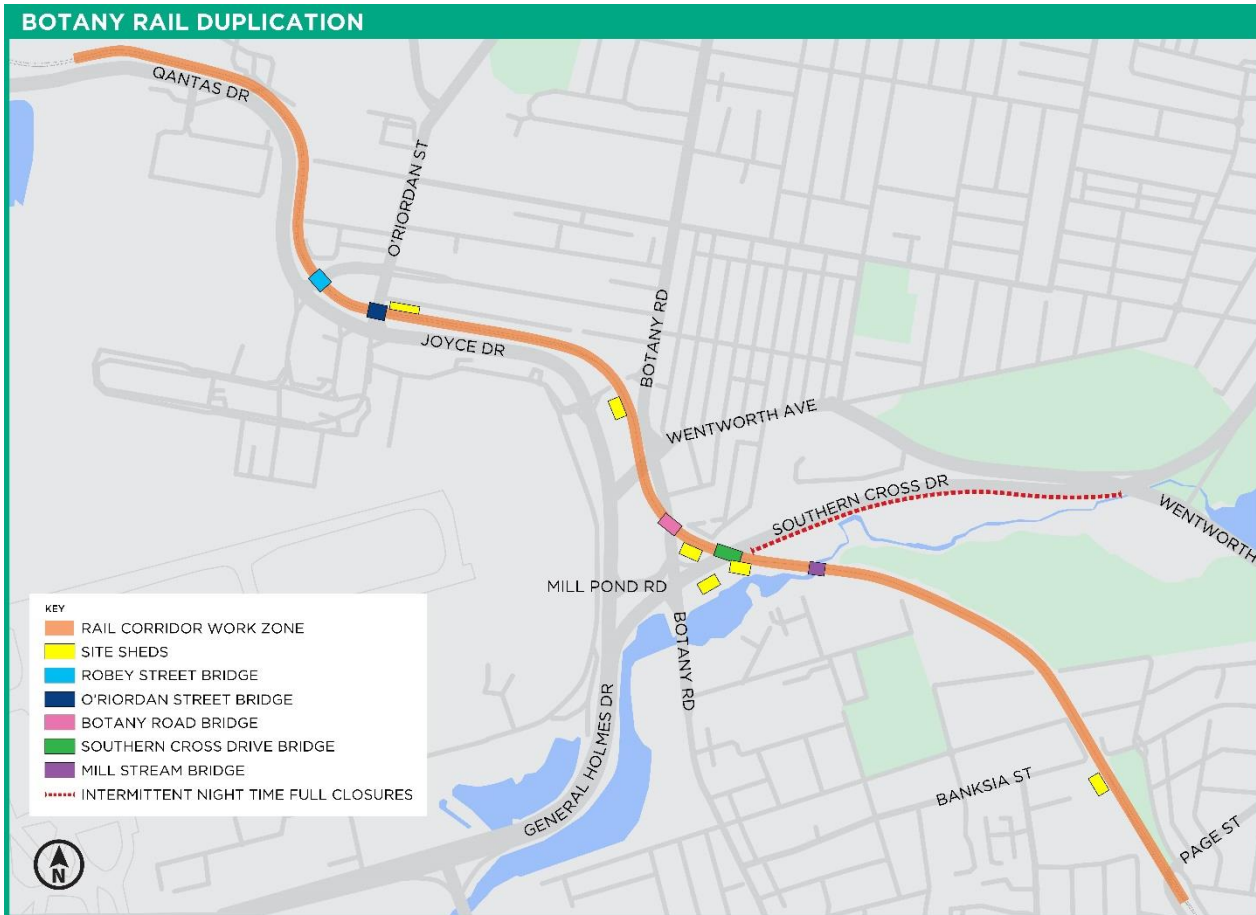
Up to eight car spaces will be temporarily out of use on Baxter Road, near O’Riordan Street, from 1 May to 31 August to allow oversize deliveries to take place.

Full closures of the Southern Cross Drive northbound and southbound carriageway may be used on an ad-hoc basis at night, with a detour via Wentworth Avenue.

Vehicles will access the rail corridor via existing access gates at Botany Road and along various project alignment access gates in the rail corridor. While most vehicles will be located inside the rail corridor during the work, some vehicles may be parked in the street close to these locations.

Intermittent lane closures on Botany Road, Southern Cross Drive, Robey Street, O’Riordan Street, Banksia Road, Mill Pond Road and McBurney Avenue may be required to facilitate site deliveries.
