WEEKEND WORK (19 JANUARY TO 22 JANUARY)

Weekend track work will be carried out in your area during a scheduled track closure. We have limited opportunities throughout the year when we can safely access the rail track and some work has to take place during pre-planned track closures to ensure the safety of workers.

Construction activities are carefully planned to minimise impacts on the community. Please see the map on the next page for the location of works.

WHEN: Weekend track closure works will take place from 9pm Friday 19 to 6am Monday 22 January

WHAT: The following activities will take place

Botany/ Pagewood/ Banksmeadow	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Track work near Banksia Street compound, including saw cutting, oxy cutting, grinding and tamping Retaining wall, concrete and drainage works between Banksia Street and Bay Street Removal of equipment at Banksia Street compound and Myrtle Street
Project alignment	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Track work, including tamping Signalling works, including concrete works, removal of existing signalling equipment and installation of new signalling equipment, testing and commissioning Rail, machinery and oversize plant materials deliveries Excavated materials transport/removal and deliveries

Equipment for this work will include excavators, tamping machine, jackhammer, rail saw, welder, oxy cutter, grader, vacuum trucks, concrete pump trucks, elevated work platforms, front end loader, roller-compactors, power hand tools, surveying equipment, semi-trailers, handheld geotechnical investigation equipment, compaction equipment, construction vehicles, lighting towers, water carts, trucks and traffic control signs and barriers.

Various measures are taken to keep noise to a minimum, such as scheduling noisier works earlier in the night where possible and installing noise blankets. The work in your area will not be continuous and every effort will be made to keep noisy work to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community where possible.

The **Noise and Vibration fact sheet** located at botanyduplication.com.au identifies construction activities and their associated noise levels in decibels (dBA). The noise levels associated with the track works have been predicted between **67dBA and 88dBA** and as a result, indicates that there may be noise impacts in your area. Directly affected residents will be provided with respite vouchers a few days prior to the works.
