

RAIL WORK NEAR YOU

Dear Neighbour,

John Holland will be carrying out works on behalf of ARTC in the rail corridor on **23 and 24 January**. The works are required to relocate trackside infrastructure and assets. We have limited opportunities throughout the year to access this area due to the rail services that travel in the corridor and will be carrying out this work during a pre-planned track closure.

The primary area of work is shown in the diagram below. The work involves use of heavy machinery, to ensure activities are performed safely and efficiently. **You may experience noisy work at times over the weekend**, including outside standard work hours.

Controls will be in place to manage potential noise impacts. Noisier activities will be scheduled during the day, although some works will be performed at night. This includes the use of concrete pumps and trucks travelling to and from the rail corridor.

Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor. While we will park our vehicles inside the rail corridor where possible, please be aware that on-street parking may be limited near the work site entry at the corner of **Station Street and Lawrence Hargrave Road**.
