

CABRAMATTA LOOP PROJECT

The Cabramatta Loop Project will increase rail freight capacity on the Southern Sydney Freight Line by allowing freight trains travelling in either direction to pass each other.

Together with the Botany Rail Duplication, it will build capacity to meet predicted growth in demand for freight to be carried on rail between Port Botany and metropolitan freight intermodal terminals. Fulton Hogan is designing and constructing the Cabramatta Loop Project for ARTC.

From 11 November 2021, our contractor Fulton Hogan will need to do some work in November to prepare for major construction works. As part of this work, there will be some tree removal and parking changes in Broomfield Street and Railway Parade, Cabramatta.

When project work in this area is completed, trees will be replaced and parking will be restored. For more information on our landscaping plans please see our fact sheet attached or visit cabramattaloop.com.au.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

From Thursday 11 November 2021, the following works activities will start in Broomfield Street, Railway Parade and within the rail corridor between Cabramatta and Warwick Farm Stations.

- **New parking in Railway Parade Cabramatta**
 - This work involves changing four parallel car parking spaces to eleven rear-to-kerb car parking spaces. We are creating these additional parking spaces before work on Broomfield Street begins. To allow for these parking changes, we will be removing two trees on Railway Parade.
- Widening the rail corridor next to Broomfield Street Cabramatta
 - To make room for the new freight track, we will be removing the trees on the railway side of Broomfield Street. These trees will be replaced, and a new retaining wall reconstructed when the project is completed.
- Preparations for widening Broomfield Street Cabramatta
 - This work will involve removing all trees on the residential side of Broomfield Street to allow for road widening. Trees will be replaced, and the street landscaped when the project is completed.
- Relocation of trackside infrastructure and assets 25-29 November near the corner of Station Street and Lawrence Hargrave Road Warwick Farm
 - This work will occur during the day as it involves noisier works such as structural steel assembly and concrete demolition.
- Railway corridor works 26-28 November 2021 between Cabramatta and Warwick Farm During this time, we will be carrying out signalling work, design investigations and fencing work. This will involve night work.



HOW MIGHT THIS WORK AFFECT YOU?

The majority of work will take place during standard construction hours, which are: Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm, and 8am to 1pm Saturdays.

Every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community wherever possible. Work dates are scheduled around current government rules and restrictions for Greater Sydney and may be subject to change. The project is committed to operating in a COVID-safe way.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow road signs or traffic controllers' directions. TRACK WORK

We have limited opportunity throughout the year to access the rail corridor. On the weekend of 26 – 28 November 2021, between 10.30pm Friday and 12am Sunday there will be a pre-planned railway track closure.

Activities during this closure will include signalling work, design investigations and fencing work.

We will work to minimise disruption to you during this time, however there will be some construction related noise, vibration and dust. During night works, we may also need to use additional, temporary lighting to enable our crews to work safely.

This work will occur between Cabramatta and Warwick Farm Stations. There will also be traffic control in place on Broomfield Street, near the Cabravale Leisure Centre, to allow trucks to safely enter and exit the site.

The work will require **temporary** closure of:

- Six to eight car parking spaces in the Railway Parade carpark, opposite Cabramatta Plaza (see map attached).
- 16 car parking spaces in Broomfield Street (opposite the Cabravale Leisure Centre) to allow equipment and trucks to safely enter and exit the rail corridor.
- 25 car parking spaces in the commuter car park near Warwick Street, Warwick Farm.

Parking spaces will be re-instated by 12am Monday 29 November 2021.

South of Cabramatta Creek near Lawrence Hargrave School, John Holland will also be carrying out works on behalf of ARTC in the rail corridor to relocate trackside infrastructure and assets, south of Cabramatta Creek. This will include noisier works such as structural steel assembly and concrete demolition works. This work will take place from 25-29 November 2021, between the hours of 7am and 6pm. Heavy vehicles will be using local streets to access the rail corridor. Traffic control will be on site to manage heavy vehicle access, local traffic and pedestrians.
