

CABRAMATTA LOOP PROJECT

The Cabramatta Loop Project will increase rail freight capacity on the Southern Sydney Freight Line by allowing freight trains travelling in either direction to pass each other. Together with the Botany Rail Duplication, it will build capacity to meet predicted growth in demand for freight to be carried on rail between Port Botany and metropolitan freight terminals. Fulton Hogan is designing and constructing the Cabramatta Loop Project for ARTC.

WHAT ARE WE DOING?

SUSSEX STREET UNDERPASS CLOSED

To complete our work safely and efficiently, we will need to temporarily close a small section of road under the rail line on Sussex Street for up to **four weeks** from mid-late May 2022. Works will include piling for the new Sussex Street underbridge and underground service upgrades, taking place during standard construction hours. Dates of the closure will be displayed on signs around the project, and affected residents will be given more information closer to the date of works.

Once piling work has been completed, the road will re-open to traffic and will operate with traffic control in place while the rest of the bridge is constructed.

During this time, cycling and pedestrian access will be maintained through the area, including along the shared path between Sussex Street and Jacquie Osmond Reserve. Please follow the directions of traffic controllers and project signage. The map below shows the detour routes during this closure.



CABRAMATTA CREEK BRIDGE WORKS

Early work to stabilise the ground for construction equipment near Cabramatta Creek will start soon. The works include piling work on the Cabramatta Creek underbridge, near Sussex Street, Cabramatta, and will begin in April 2022.

The temporary path, next to the cycleway between Sussex Street and Jacquie Osmond Reserve, will be open to maintain access for pedestrians and cyclists between Cabramatta and Warwick Farm. Work on the bridge is expected to last for approximately **three to four months**, weather permitting. BROOMFIELD STREET

New stormwater drains have been installed on the residential side between Sussex Street and Junction Street, Cabramatta. Work has now moved further north between Junction Street and Bridge Street.

Work on underground water services has also begun. Starting at the southern end of Broomfield Street, near Sussex Street, crews will move north towards Cabramatta train station. Work will include replacing and upgrading the water main along Broomfield Street, as well as removing and reinstating the footpath and nature strip. To do this we need to close the footpath on the residential side of the street. We ask that you please use the footpath available on the railway side during this work. Access to properties will be maintained throughout. This work is expected to take 3-4 months, weather dependent. Once finished, work will switch to the railway side of the street.

HOW MIGHT THIS WORK AFFECT YOU?

The majority of work will take place during standard construction hours, which are: **Monday to Friday, 7am to 6pm, and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**. Every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community wherever possible.

Please keep to the speed limits and follow road signs or traffic controllers' directions.
