

# CABRAMATTA LOOP PROJECT

The Cabramatta Loop Project will increase rail freight capacity on the Southern Sydney Freight Line by constructing a new 1.65km section of track, allowing freight trains travelling in either direction to pass each other. Fulton Hogan is designing and constructing the Cabramatta Loop Project for ARTC.

## PROPOSED OUT OF HOURS WORK SCHEDULE

This community update contains information about our proposed schedule of works outside standard construction hours, over the next three months.

We have limited opportunities throughout the year when we can access the rail corridor. In September, October and November 2023, there are pre-planned weekend railway track closures for the Cabramatta Loop Project. We will be working on the rail network in Canley Vale, Cabramatta, Warwick Farm and Liverpool. Maps showing the work locations can be found on pages 2 and 3.

We will also work outside standard construction hours in Broomfield Street (between Sussex Street and Bridge Street) and Jacquie Osmond Reserve in Cabramatta.

The table below provides indicative information about the works currently planned **outside standard construction hours** over the next three months. Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

**NOTE: We may need to work outside standard construction hours up to 3 nights, 1 Saturdays and 1 Sundays per month for work inside the rail corridor, and 8 nights per month and 2 additional Saturday afternoons per month for works outside the rail corridor.**

## HOW MIGHT THIS WORK AFFECT YOU

Some of this work may be noisy and disruptive, however every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community wherever possible. Some of the measures we may use include turning off equipment when not in use, installing noise blankets and using non-tonal ('white noise') reversing alarms on vehicles.

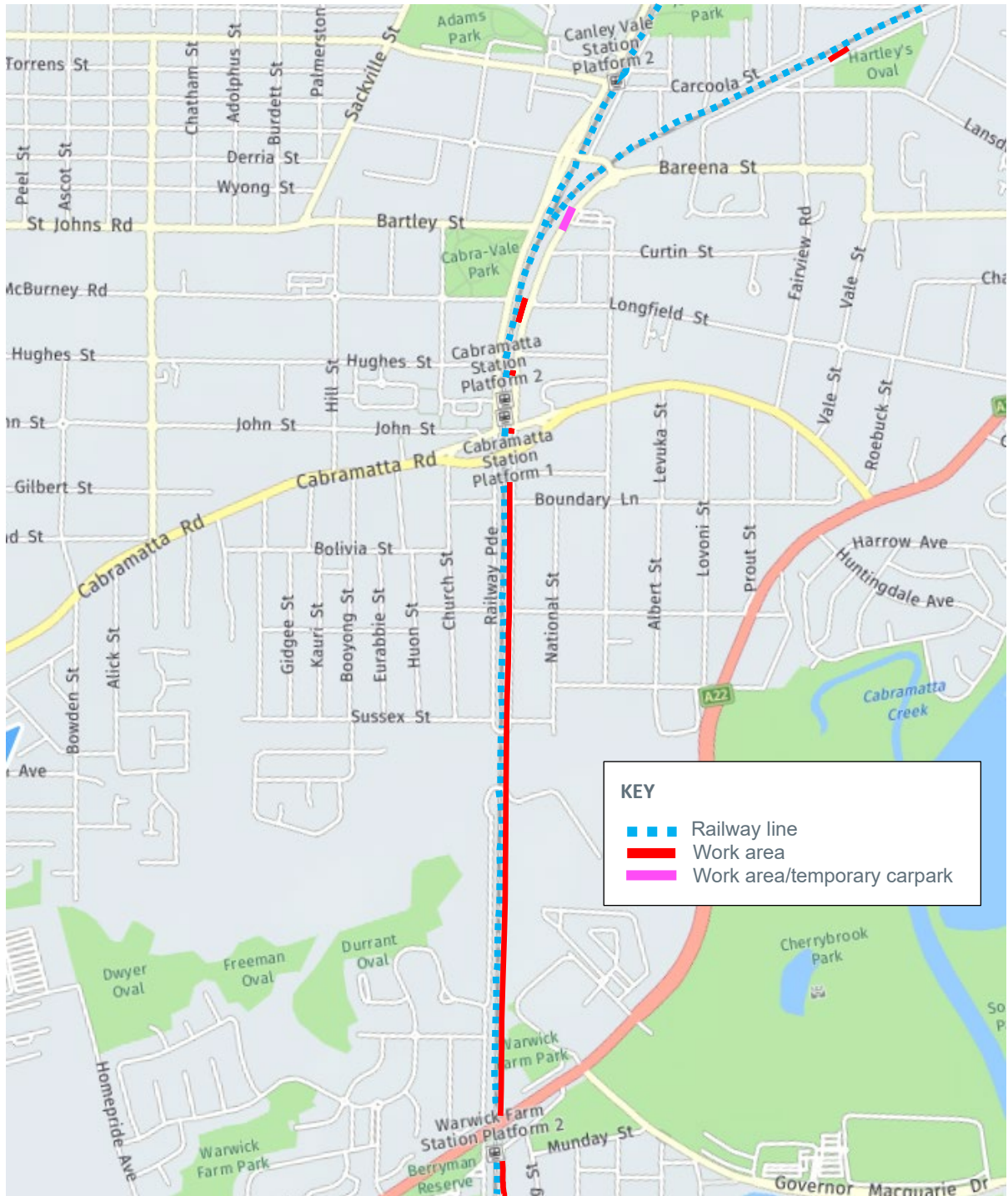

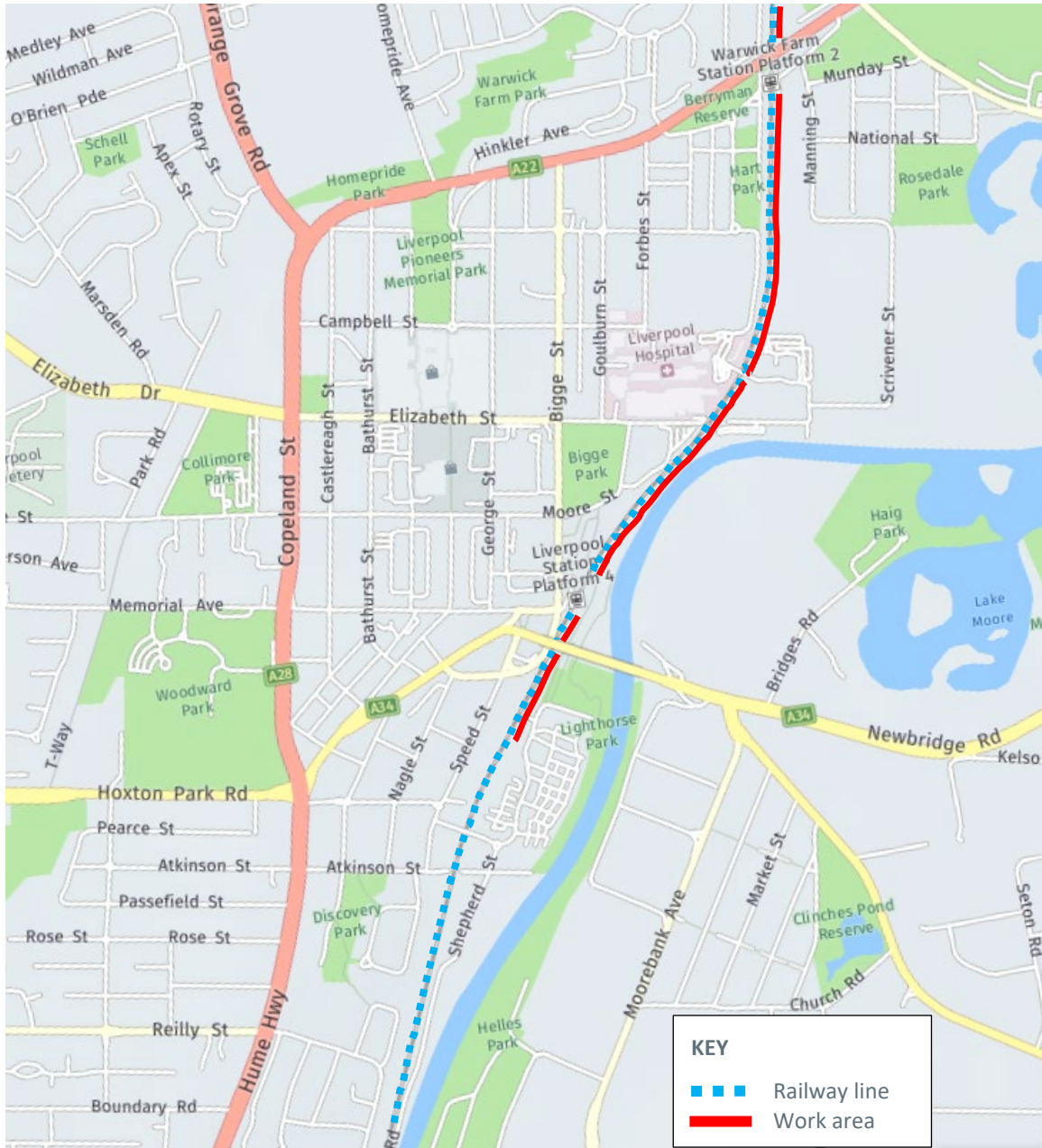
