# CABRAMATTA LOOP PROJECT

16 August 2023 **CLP 38** 

The Cabramatta Loop Project will increase rail freight capacity on the Southern Sydney Freight Line by constructing a new 1.65km section of track, allowing freight trains travelling in either direction to pass each other. Fulton Hogan is designing and constructing the Cabramatta Loop Project for ARTC.

#### RAIL CORRIDOR OUT OF HOURS WEEKEND WORK

We have limited opportunities throughout the year when we can access the rail corridor to work near the tracks. There is a pre-planned railway track closure this month, and the Cabramatta Loop Project will work from 1pm Saturday 26 August to 10pm Sunday 27 August 2023.

We will be working between Villawood and Casula stations. Maps showing the work locations can be found on the next pages. Construction activities will include earthworks, drainage and demolition works, noise panel removal, signalling works and cable pulling. The team will also work during standard construction hours, which are 7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and Saturdays 8am to 1pm.

#### **HOW MIGHT THIS WORK AFFECT YOU?**

Equipment used will include excavators, vacuum trucks, traffic control signs and barriers, rollers, power hand tools, surveying equipment, construction vehicles, lighting towers, pumps, generators, hammers, sawcutters and work trucks.

Some of this work may be noisy and disruptive, however every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community wherever possible. Some of the measures we will use include turning off equipment when not in use, setting up noise blankets around work sites where possible and using nontonal ('white noise') reversing alarms on vehicles. Works will be monitored to make sure noise levels are being managed effectively. You can find out more information about noise and vibration in the fact sheet on our website cabramattaloop.com.au.




Figure 2 – Broomfield Street, Cabramatta

#### PROPOSED UPCOMING OUT OF HOURS WORK SCHEDULE

The following table provides indicative information about the works currently planned outside standard construction hours. The timing or type of work may change due to weather or other unforeseen circumstances. Further information about these works will be provided in the project's community notifications at least five days before the works take place.

NOTE: We may need to work outside standard construction hours up to 8 nights and 8 Saturday afternoons per month for work inside the rail corridor, 8 nights per month and 2 additional Saturday afternoons per month for works outside the rail corridor, at each location.

## BROOMFIELD STREET NOISE WALL INSTALLATION (DAY WORK) UPDATE

The old retaining wall will be removed inside the rail corridor.

The noise wall crew is aiming to complete the new retaining wall and noise wall panel installation on Broomfield Street:

- between Sussex Street and Junction Street by mid-late September
- between Junction Street and Bridge Street by late September/early October.

We will need to do minor work on the panels after they are installed. Areas of the shared path and onstreet parking lane will be occupied by the workers and their equipment during minor work activities like patching and painting.
