

CABRAMATTA LOOP PROJECT

The Cabramatta Loop Project will increase rail freight capacity on the Southern Sydney Freight Line by constructing a new 1.65km section of track, allowing freight trains travelling in either direction to pass each other. Fulton Hogan is designing and constructing the project for ARTC.

PROPOSED OUT OF HOURS WORK SCHEDULE

This community update contains information about our proposed schedule of works outside standard construction hours, over the next six months.

UPCOMING ROAD UPGRADE ACTIVITIES ON BROOMFIELD STREET, CABRAMATTA

Road resurfacing and line marking activities will take place on Broomfield Street between Bridge Street and Sussex Street **between Monday 6 November to Friday 17 November 2023**. There will be six work shifts over this period with crews working from **7am to midnight**. Due to the nature of the work, temporary lane or road closures and detours may be in place.

Vehicle access to residential properties will be maintained at all times. If you live or visit a property in Broomfield Street, please speak to the traffic controller and they will provide you with vehicle access to the property during the temporary road closures.

RAIL CORRIDOR WEEKEND WORK

We have limited opportunities throughout the year when we can access the rail corridor. Between November 2023 and March 2024, there are pre-planned weekend railway track closures for the Cabramatta Loop Project. We will be working on the rail network in Canley Vale, Cabramatta, Warwick Farm and Liverpool. Maps showing the work locations can be found on pages 3 and 4.

NOTE: We may need to work outside standard construction hours up to 3 nights, 1 Saturdays and 1 Sundays per month for work inside the rail corridor. This is in addition to 8 nights per month and 2 additional Saturday afternoons per month for works outside the rail corridor.

An additional community notification, with more information about the construction activities, will be provided at least five days before the out of hours work take place.

The table below provides information about the works currently planned to take place **outside standard construction hours** over the next six months. Standard construction hours are **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday, and 8am to 1pm Saturdays**.

HOW MIGHT THIS WORK AFFECT YOU

Some of this work may be noisy and disruptive, however every effort will be made to keep noisy works to a minimum and reduce impacts to the community wherever possible. Some of the measures we may use include working during standard hours where possible, turning off equipment when not in use, installing noise blankets and using non-tonal ('white noise') reversing alarms on vehicles.

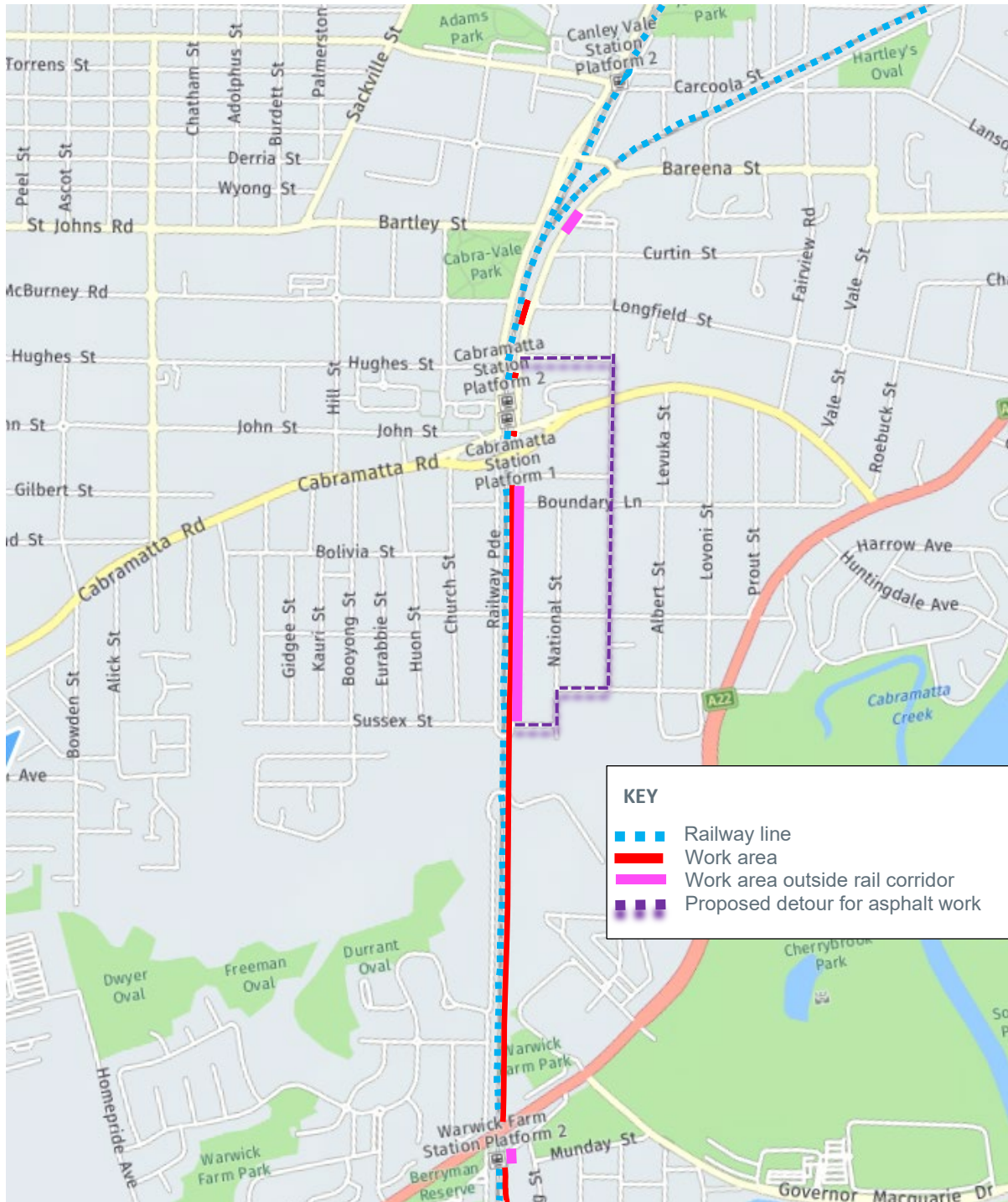
When work is required at night, high-noise work will be carried out for a maximum of two consecutive nights per week. Where high-noise work is anticipated for an extended period of time, mitigation measures and treatments will be discussed with residents depending on the expected noise levels at each property. When high-noise work takes place during the day, one hour of respite will be provided for every three hours of high-noise work. Respite periods can be varied if agreed with impacted residents and stakeholders.

The **Noise and Vibration fact sheet** located on our website cabramattaloop.com.au identifies construction activities and their associated noise levels in decibels (dBA). It also contains information about how we assess and manage noise and vibration impacts.

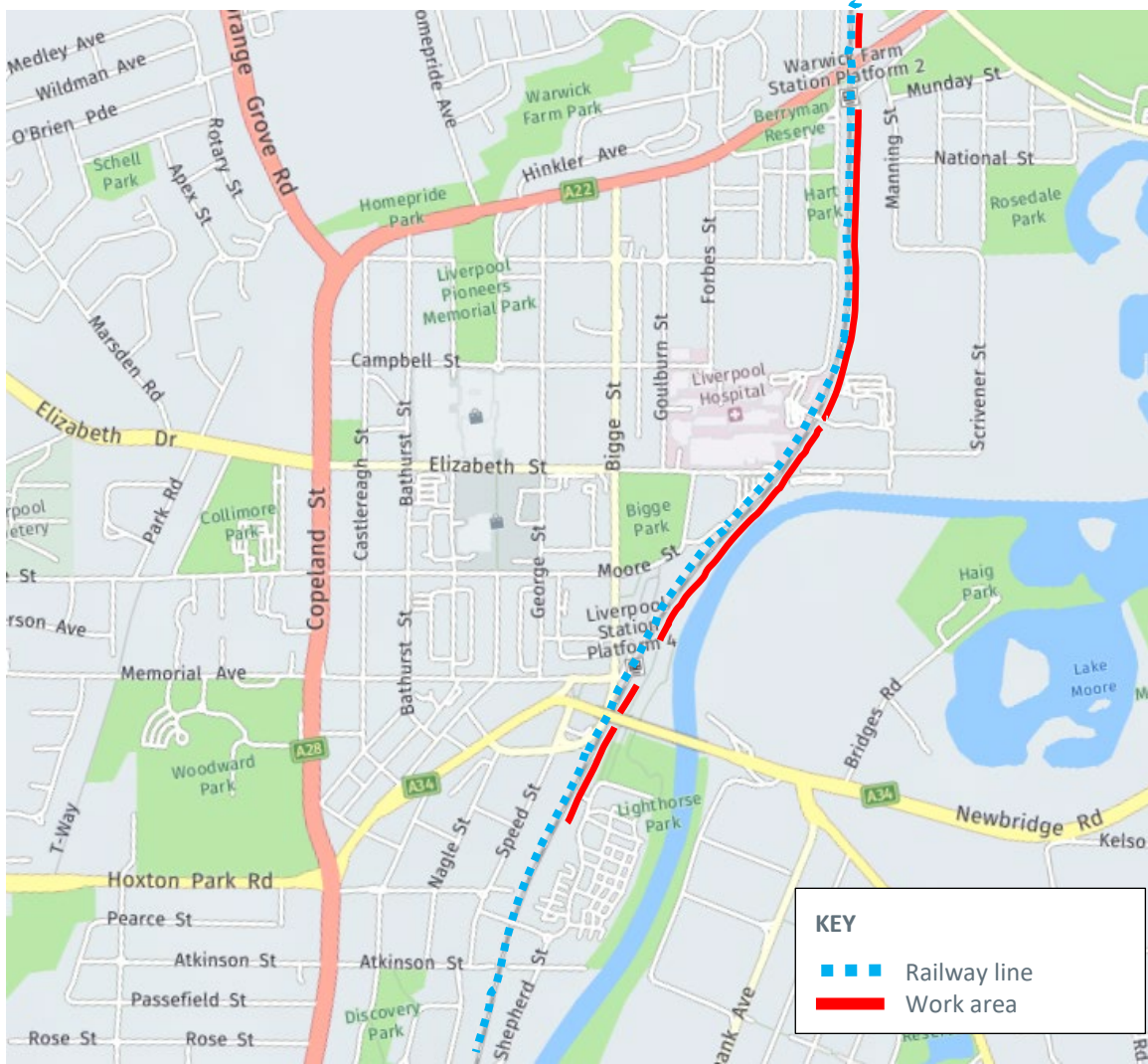
